The mission of Aktion Club is to provide adults with disabilities an opportunity to develop initiative and leadership, to serve their community, to be integrated into society, and to demonstrate the dignity and value of citizens living with disabilities. The evening will include a presentation by Steve Oltmans, the Mayor's Chief of Staff, and Kiwanis Club of Omaha president Bob Kenny. A reception with pizza and refreshments and a dance to follow with music by disc jockey Steve Rock.

Aktion Club members strive to return to their communities the benefits, help, and caring they have received, as well as develop important skills in the process. Through the assistance of Kiwanis Club of Omaha, Inc., Mosaic's Aktion club was officially chartered on Aug. 19, 2009 with 30 members.
