### **MOSAIC ACQUIRES BRIDGES COMMUNITY CARE**

*National provider will begin services July 1*

PITTSBURG, Kansas – Mosaic, a national, faith-based organization providing services to people with intellectual disabilities, has signed an agreement to assume the services provided by Bridges Community Care effective July 1.

“This is a great fit for Mosaic and for Bridges,” said Penny Knoll Massa, Regional Vice President for Mosaic. “The two organizations both put people first and have similar values underpinning the services we provide. Mosaic's national resources will enhance the quality services that Bridges already provides and create a premier agency in Pittsburg and Coffeyville.”

Bridges currently serves more than 138 people through residential and day services, case management, employment coordination, supported living and other services. It employs 160 staff members. The transition was announced to employees, clients and their guardians and family members June 4. Bridges was founded and operated by Wes Graham and provides services through locations in Pittsburg and Coffeyville.

Mosaic's headquarters are in Omaha, Neb., and the organization already has locations in Garden City, Liberal, Kansas City, Winfield and Ellsworth in Kansas.
