Age will be based on grade level as of July 17, 2010. Volunteers will be needed to help score and time and will also receive a free T-shirt. Shoot for the highest score from the free throw line within 5 minutes.

Shoot Out Rules

1. The free throw line is the only place for shooting.
2. A player must have their feet behind the free throw line when the shot is taken. No points will be scored on that shot if violated.
3. A player must get his or her own rebound.
4. If the ball goes out of bounds, the clock will not be stopped while the ball is retrieved.
5. Ties will be settled by a one round shoot off.
